Condition: This instrument is in excellent condition.

Comments: This cello is made in Germany of European maple and spruce with good acoustic properties. It is a responsive and clear sounding instrument with good potential. The antiquing of the varnish was done by the makers.



Description: This instrument has a two-piece maple back, showing small flame, running horizontal in the upper back then descending slightly in the lower bout. The sides and neck are of similar wood. The neck is of lighter figure. The two-piece front is of spruce showing medium grain becoming broader towards the centre. The fittings and the fingerboard are of ebony. The varnish is of a reddish brown colour in excellent condition. There are no visible repairs.

Back measurements:

Length: 756mm. Upper bout: 353mm. Middle bout: 244mm. Lower bout: 438mm.
